



## NSW Snowy Mountains Road and Vehicle Regulations for Winter 2011

While Kosciuszko's mountain roads take you to many spectacular places you do need to take a few precautions and be aware that weather and road conditions can change dramatically in a short space of time.

---

<b>ALPINE WAY:</b>	Chains <b>must</b> be carried in all two-wheel drive vehicles during the winter season <b>between Thredbo and Tom Groggin.</b>
<b>KOSCIUSZKO ROAD TO PERISHER:</b>	Chains <b>must</b> be carried in all two-wheel drive vehicles on the Kosciuszko Road <b>from the park boundary.</b>
<b>KOSCIUSZKO RD PERISHER TO CHARLOTTE PASS:</b>	This road will be closed to vehicle access once it becomes impassable due to snow. Access to Charlotte Pass Village is by oversnow transport.
<b>GUTHEGA ROAD:</b>	Chains <b>must</b> be carried in all two wheel drive vehicles during the winter season.
<b>SNOWY MTNS HWY:</b>	It is recommended but not compulsory that all vehicles carry chains between Cooma and Tumut during the winter season.
<b>KIANDRA TO CABRAMURRA/ MT SELWYN LINK ROAD:</b>	It is recommended but not compulsory that all vehicles carry chains during the winter season.
<b>CABRAMURRA TO KHANCOBAN ROAD:</b>	This road is closed from the NSW June long weekend to the NSW October long weekend.
<b>ELLIOTT WAY:</b>	It is recommended but not compulsory that all vehicles carry chains along this road during the winter season.

Roads with compulsory chain requirements are not suitable for motorbikes and caravans during the winter season
